

Catton Park

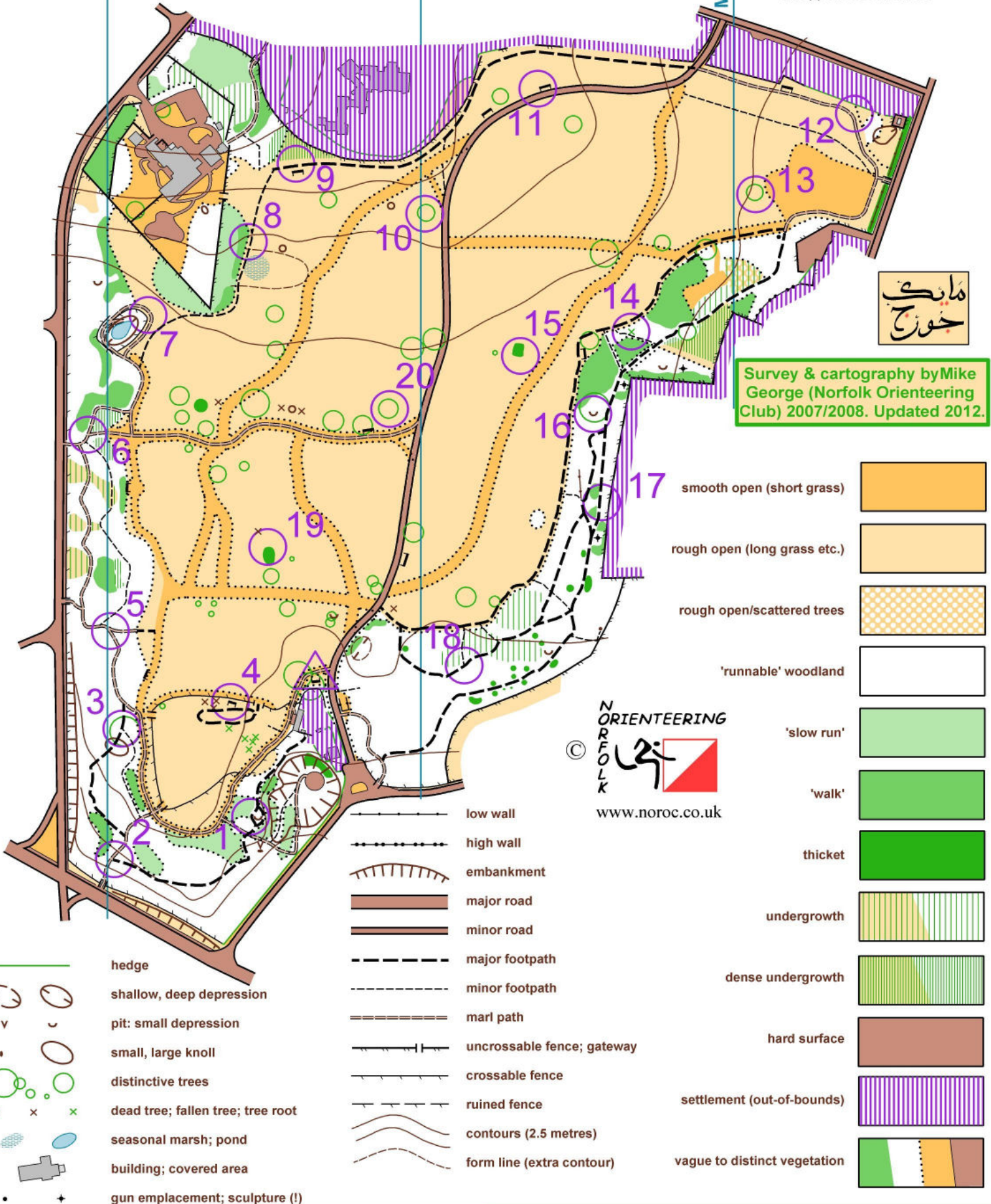
